WILLIAM WOODLEY AND LUCY MARSH (G14-ASHDON)

This family seems to have been based in the City of London, and is perhaps connected with another Woodley family living in Stepney. A member of this family moved to Ashdon in Essex around 1740 and was ancestor to a large number of Essex Woodleys. Given the density of Woodleys in this part of Essex it is possible he already had family ties there.

Despite the Great Fire of 1666 a great many earlier City records survived as they were stored in Westminster.

See the file 'Clandestine Churches' which particularly concerns (1) St Brides, Fleet (St BFS) and (2) St James, Duke Place

We have to start in the early 1600s with what we classify as GENERATION 4 (G4) to maintain consistency with other families. The early records are a bit random until we get to G8

The highlighted marriages seem to form a consistent set.

Jane Woodley wife of Henry Woodley died 12/11/1619 St BFS

It is not impossible that this is Henry Woodley #9605 of Rickling (son of Richard #6300) who, having been left no land may have sought his fortune in London, but this is pure speculation

Edward Woodley married Grace Ripton in Cornhill 1/4/1605

John Woodlye married Jone Bridges 13/10/1628 in Clerkenwell

Thomas Woodley married Mary Arnold 3/3/1635 St Mary Magdelene, Old Fish Street, near St Pauls

Nicholas Woodley bapd 22/4/1593 St B FS, son of Drew Woodley

William Woodley married Eliz Githings 5/8/1639 Holborn

Henry Woodley married Sisley Couler or Tailer 18/8/1653 St Anne Westminster

John Woodley married Joyce Bright 18/2/1654 Holborn

Henry Woodley and Ann

Children: Henry W bapt 24/12/1653 St Brides Fleet Street(G7) Thomas W bapt 30/8/1656 St B FS (G7) Pressily bapt 19/9/1658 St B FS (G7)

Roger Woodley married Elizabeth Greenway 23/10/1660 Holborn

Richard Woodley married Martha Barret or Carrot 23/8/1668 in Clerkenwell, not far from Holborn

CHARLES WOODLEY AND HELENA PRICE (G8 - LONDON)

Charles Woodley (#6000) probably born around 1666 married Helena or Ellin Price (#6001) on 1st Sept 1687 at St James Duke Place

Charles may have married a second time on 3rd Dec 1700 at Fleet St nonconformist church

They had several children including

- .1 Margaret (#6002) bapt 6th Dec 1689 Clerkenwell
- .2 Catherine
- .3 Mary b 1693 Southwark, died 1694
- .4 John (#8652) bapt 26th July 1688 Clerkenwell.

JOHN WOODLEY AND ANN (G9-LONDON)

John Woodley #8652 bapt 26th July 1688 Clerkenwell., 'son of Charles and Elin', married Ann #8653 6th Jun 1711 at St Brides Fleet Street.

He may have had a brother or cousin, Jonathan Woodley married 8th May 1711 at St Brides Fleet Street

John and Ann had a son James (#201, G10-Ashdon) born 1715 London, baptised on 14th Sept 1715 at St Andrews by the Wardrobe with St Anne's Blackfriars, 'son of John and **Ann**'.

This son James married Ann Senior (#202) 29th Jan 1738 at St Brides Fleet Street.

John and Ann also had a son David #8654 in 1713 in London

JAMES WOODLEY AND ANN(E) SENIOR (G10-ASHDON)

James Woodley

All we know for sure is that the James we are interested in died and was buried 2nd March 1788 as recorded in All Saints Ashdon cemetry by 'findagrave' and this record suggests a birth year of 1715.

If we consider his possible marriage to Ann Senior in London (see below) then the most likely candidate for that marriage is James Woodley bapt 14th Sept 1715 at St Andrews Blackfriars, son of John and Anne.

Originally it was thought that James Woodley (#201) was *possibly* the son of William Woodley (#305) and Agnes Purcas (#306) and was supposedly born 1715 in Ashdon or Radwinter, Essex. There is no obvious birth record and we only have the birth year from his age when he died. There was no other couple actively having babies in the Ashdon area at that time.

According to another source he was the son born 1689 of William Woodley and Ann Glass but there is nothing to support this.

Ann Senior

The best record available for Ann is the Ashdon cemetry (findagrave) and church burial record of Ann Woodley who was buried a pauper in Ashdon 12th Feb 1794, age 74, five years after the death of James. Her birth year was estimated as 1720. Her children were born between 1742 (when she was 22) and 1760 (when she was 40), so that makes some biological sense.

Not much is known about James' wife Ann(e), though she might be Ann Senior (#202) chr 8th Oct 1716 at St Andrew's Holborn to Richard and Martha Senior, and she had sisters Cary 1714, Jane 1713. also bapt at St Andrews Holborn.

There is a clear record in the LDS database that James Woodley married Ann Senior 29th Jan 1738 at St Brides Fleet Street, London.

But there was a well-established family of Woodleys who used this church and they had been in London from 1650, so making it unlikely that the James in this marriage came from Essex, and that he was in fact baptised 1715 in Blackfriars.

There is another opinion that Ann was in fact Mary Ann Kinsella, born London, but I have seen no evidence to support this. James and Mary Ann Kinsella were also married at St Brides Fleet Street in 1738 bu I cannot find a record.

The following early hypothesis is also now rejected

"It seems on the face of it most likely that James married in Ashdon to a local girl, of which there were only 2 Anns of the right age- Ann Sparks and Ann Thurnhill -and that the marriage record is simply lost. A number of Ashdon marriage records cannot be found, suggesting either a lost volume or more likely marriages here were not formalised in church. Essex is a hot-bed of non-conformism. Ann Thurnhill was bapt 26th Jun 1720, making her the right age. This is of course very tenuous but is even so more likely than the other names put forward - ie Senior and Kinsella, but alas Ann Thurnhill dau of John and Mary died as an infant in July 1720. Ann Sparks was bapt 27th Jul 1725 in Ashdon and only married Joseph Elliston in 1762 - so she could have been the widow of James Woodley, except that our Ann died as Ann Woodley"

MARRIAGE

James Woodley of St Ann's Blackfriars married Ann Senior of St Brides, Fleet Street on 29th Jan 1738.

A distinct possibility is that James and Ann were both brought up in London but for whatever reason happened to move against the tide to live in Ashdon, Essex. This is not without precedent because in 1731 Samuel Woodley and Martha Holliday moved from their families in Stepney to live in Kelvedon. Indeed 1739 was considered a very bad year for life in London due to recession and a growing population. It was in 1739 that Thomas Coram created the foundling hospital for the many abandoned London children.

Whatever the case, James and Ann lived in Ashdon near Saffron Walden

CHILDREN

James and Ann had ten children.

All christenings of the 10 children of James and Ann were at Ashdon parish church

.1 Sarah (#209), chr 20th July 1760 - mother Ann would have been 44, unusually old, but this could be an adult baptism! Unfortunately the record simply reads "bapt 20th July 1760 Sarah dr of John and Anne Woodley".

Sarah Woodley **could** have married widower Richard Mathes in Danbury 1778, but that could equally be Sarah 1748 dau of John and Frances Woodley of Manuden, although Danbury is in Chelmsford a long way from either Ashdon or Manuden..

.2 John, (#101) chr 27th July 1755, married Mary Weard (#102) in 1779. There were several marriages of John Woodley to a Mary around this time - to Mary Weard 1779, to Mary Archer 1785 and to Mary Greenleaf 1798, and a lot of children in each case.

One of these three 'John and Mary' marriages had a daughter Amelia Woodley 1789 and she married William Smart 1812 and had a daughter Mary Smart 1831 who was in this census with her grandmother. John (#101) died 1838 (findagrave, Ashdon cemetry)

Skip to John Woodley (#101) and Mary Weard

- .3 Anne (#211), chr 24th Feb 1744, died in infancy
- <u>.4 Thomas (#212)</u>, <u>c</u>hr 7th April 1751 (Ashdon to James and Ann) He is very likely the Thomas that married Sarah Barker in Radwinter, very close to Ashdon.
- .5 Elizabeth (#205), chr 23rd Feb 1745 (Ashdon, to James and Ann), possibly married John Clarke (#8174) 1773, but she could have had an illegitimate child with unknown father (#2303) George (#8171) bapt 13th Apr 1766 before her marriage. George (single) married Hannah Slogrove (#8172) (widow) on 28th July 1793 in Ashdon. (John Slogrove married Hannah Barker 26th Jun 1783 and on John's death she married George Woodley.

George Woodley buried 16th Mar 1834 Ashdon age 68 (born 1766)

.6 William (#203), chr 15th January 1743, married Jane Norris (#213) in Tilty in 1771. Two children Jane (#217) 1772 (bapt 6th Mar 1772) and John (#215) 1773

- .7 Mary (#206), chr 6th November 1748 in Ashdon married Isaac Chapman (#8401) and they had three children, Ann, Harry and William.
- .8 Agnes (#207), chr 27th January 1754, appears not to have married
- .9 Daniel (#208), chr 5th March 1758 Ashdon to James and Ann, married Sarah Carpenter (#8173) 23rd Apr 1797 in Ashdon. (Daniel was single but Sarah was a widow, probably Sarah Paul widow of John Carpenter of Langdon Hills)
- .10 James (#204), (1742-1808) chr 27th June 1742, who married Elizabeth (#214) (b1748) This is either Elizabeth Brown or Elizabeth Flechford or (more likely) Hitchford, married 27th Nov 1766. In the indexes James is listed as 'Havers'. They had three children James (#228)

1766, Jane (#229) 1768 (bapt 13th Mar 1768) and Hannah (#230) (1769-1819).

Hannah (#230) married Joseph Lofts (#231) (1764-1824) and their son Charles Lofts (#4132) (1809-1853) married Sarah Woodley (#4125) (1817-1895) daughter of William Woodley (#1413) 1787-1862 and Mary Ann Flack (#4120) (-1820) - though these were a distant family from the Manuden branch.

There were three marriages of Hannah Woodley around this time - but unfortunately only one eligible birth of Hannah Woodley, though feasibly in one case Woodley might be the name from a previous marriage.

- .1 Hannah Woodley married John Truman 11th March 1791 Essex no marital status given, perhaps she was a widow.
- .2 Hannah Woodley married James Martin 25th Jan 1792 in Essex, both single.
- .3 Hannah Woodley married Joseph Lofts 6th Dec 1791 in Ashdon, both single.

If Hannah Woodley is a widow then the two contenders are Susannah Woodley who married John Francis 1774 Susannah Gregory who married Thomas Woodley 1788, though this couple were still having children in 1799.

There was a previously un-noticed Hanah Woodly (sic) bapt 9th July 1770 dau of James who would fit the bill of marrying Truman and/or Martin.

So feasibly

Hannah #230 married Joseph Lofts
Hanah Woodly married James Martin
Susannah Woodley who died 1787 married John Francis but could
not have married John Truman
We still have no idea who married John Truman.

NOTE

James son of Ann Senior 1738 Ashdon and James (#703) son of Frances Hammond 1742 Manuden each married either Elizabeth Brown 1765 Linton or Elizabeth Flechford 1766 Essex

In fact Brown looks more likely for THIS James #204

THOMAS WOODLEY AND SARAH BARKER (G11-WIMBISH)

Wimbish, Radwinter and Ashdon are very close to each other.

Thomas Woodley (#212), chr 7th April 1751 (Ashdon to James and Ann)

Sarah Barker (#2802)

There are a lot of Sarah Barkers that are possible but the likeliest are Sarah Barker bapt 14/8/1763 Ashdon to Robert and Mary and

Sarah Barker bapt 05/7/1772 Ashdon to Robert and Mary Normally this might have implied that the first died young and the name was re-used for the later child. If so Sarah would be only 16 when she married Thomas. Or she could have been baptised a second time when she was 21 in which case she was 25 at marriage.

Married 26th Oct 1788 in Wimbish/Radwinter

This marriage doesn't appear in familysearch In Essex Marriages and Banns 1537-1935 (findmypast) it appears as: "Thomas Woodley of Radwinter married Sarah Marker of Radwinter 1/11/1788 in Radwinter

Thomas would be at least 37 so this could be a second marriage - or the wrong Thomas, though there is no other obvious candidate..

Note possible relatives: Elizabeth Woodley married James Barker 21/1/1804 Radwinter and Mary Woodley and Robert Daking marred 1/3/1804 Radwinter

CHILDREN

Thomas (#2803) born 2nd or 22nd Feb 1797, bapt 20th or 26th Feb 1797 in Wimbish died 1816.

Ann (#2804) born 11th Mar 1797, bapt 5th May 1797 in Wimbish

but note these are born too close together to make any sense. There must be 2 sets of parents.

Alice b 1793 d infancy

Sarah # 8671 bapt 19th May 1801 Wimbish dau of Thomas and Sarah

All definitely had parents "Thomas and Sarah".

WILLIAM WOODLEY AND JANE NORRIS (G11-ASHDON)

William Woodley (#203) (1743-1822) was christened 15th January 1743 at Ashdon near Saffron Walden, the son of James Woodley (#201) and Anne Senior (#202) of Ashdon,. William was buried either 7th September 1812 or 5th November 1822.

Jane Norris (#213) was christened 11th March 1743 in Tilty, near Saffron Walden, daughter of William Norris (chr 15th April 1717) and Jane. Her grandfather was Isaac Norris of Thaxted near Saffron Walden. There are two possibilities both in Thaxted-

- .1 Isaac chr 30th Nov 1689 to William and Ann Norris
- .2 Isaac chr 16th April 1699 to Isaac and Martha.

MARRIAGE

William Woodley and Jane Norris were married 7th May 1771 in the village of Tilty, near Saffron Walden.

CHILDREN

William and Jane had two children, John and Jane.

.1 John Woodley (#215) 1773-1833, was christened 4th June 1773. He married Sarah Goodwin (#216) (1772-1861) in 1810 and they moved from rural Ashdon into a down-at-heel area of Saffron Walden. Their children were: John (#2401) 1813, Sarah (221) 1815, Charlotte (#223) 1815, Elizabeth (#220) 1817/21 and Ann (#218) 1818 (when Sarah Goodwin was 46!)

John and Sarah would have been quite old (38) when they married. It is certainly feasible, but not proven, that John had previously married Elizabeth x (#8409) in 1800. There is a small chance he married Mary Stock (#8410)

.2 Jane Woodley (#217), born 1772, was christened 6th March 1772. She died 1842. She married John Atkinson (#4001) (1772-1853) on 15th Oct 1795 in Virley, and had seven children: Charles (1801-1881), Simeon (1802-1825), John (1807-1814), Joseph (1813-), Elizabeth (1817-), John (1818-), Sophia (1818-)

Charles and Simeon were both bapt 9th Jan 1803 in Saffron Walden Charles 1801 married Mary Ann Whte in 1823 Simeon 1802 married Mary Ann Clayden in 1840

Hannah Woodley (#230) bapt 10th Dec 1769 Ashdon, dau of James Woodley and Elizabeth Brown, and grand-daughter of James Woodley and Ann Senior

They were married 6th Dec 1791 in Ashdon

JOHN WOODLEY AND MARY WEARD (G11-ASHDON)

John Woodley

John Woodley (#101) chr 27th July 1755 "son of James and Ann", died 1838, son of James Woodley (#201) b1715 and Anne Senior (#202) who were married in London of a London-based family and moved to Ashdon..

Ashdon church record: "John Woodley buried 1st Jul 1838 age 80, Ashdon" (ie born 1758)

Mary Weard

Mary Weard (#102) (1755 -1823) died 16th Jan 1823

findagrave record : "Mary Woodley died 1823 age 67-68 Ashdon" (ie born 1755 or 1756)

Wyard is the more common spelling in Essex, but even so there is no record of her birth.

MARRIAGE

John Woodley (#101) married Mary Weard (#102) on 6th Apr 1779 in Ashdon.

CHILDREN

- .1 THOMAS 1785, married Sarah Webb
- .2 WILLIAM 1783, married Susan Coote
- .3 AMELIA 1789, married William Smart
- .4 STEPHEN 1791, married (1) Mary Taylor and (2) Eliza Wright

- .6 MARY 1787, married John Webb
- **.7 ELIZABETH 1792**
- **.8 MARTHA 1797**

Originally it was thought that John Woodley who married Metty Greenleaf was a child in this family, but this is now discounted.

.1 THOMAS (#105) b 1785 d 1847 who married Sarah Webb (#121) (1796-1865), married 2nd Dec 1814 in Castle Camps, Cambridgeshire. Sarah Webb was dau of William and Mary Webb, b 1794. Although the marriage was in Castle Camps the family remained in Ashdon - or at least continued to use Ashdon church.

Note that there is confusion between the children of Thomas Woodley and Sarah Parr and those of Thomas Woodley and Sarah Webb, both having children in Ashdon about the same time.

THOMAS WOODLEY AND SARAH WEBB G12- ASHDON)

THOMAS (#105) b 1785 d 1847, son of John Woodley and Mary Weard, who married **Sarah Webb** (#121) (1796-1865), married 2nd Dec 1814 in Castle Camps, Cambridgeshire.

Sarah Webb (#121) b 1794 was dau of William and Mary Webb.

Although the marriage was in Castle Camps the family remained in Ashdon - or at least continued to use Ashdon church.

Note that there is confusion between the children of Thomas Woodley and Sarah Parr and those of Thomas Woodley and Sarah Webb, both having children in Ashdon about the same time.

Thomas Woodley and Sarah Webb had 10 children between 1815 and 1838. Their children are generally named 'Webb Woodley' - thus Rachel Webb Woodley and William Webb Woodley - in the parish registers, to avoid confusion with other Woodleys in Ashdon,.

On 17th Oct 1848 Charles Lofts, 'age 36 with imperfect education' was sentenced at the County Assizes to 7 years transportation for 'larceny by servant'. This was one month before the birth of his son John on 21st Nov 1848.

"Extensive corn stealing - Chas Lofts a labourer was indicted for stealing a quantity of corn to the value of £9 from James and Abraham Seward of Ashdon. Mr Hawkins for the prosecution. Mr Parnell for the defence. It appeared that the prisoner had been a horsekeeper in the service of the prosecutors ..."

In 1851 Charles Lofts was in Chelmsford Gaol and in 1852 he went to Tasmania (Van Diemens Land) on 16th Apr 1852 on the 'Pestonjee Bomanjee'. The surgeon on board, Daniel Ritchie was an advocate of good treatment of prisoners and kept a chronicle of the voyage but as yet this is not available online. Considering that in 1854 a voyage by the same ship carrying voluntary migrants resulted in many deaths from fever the conditions must still have been bad.

Charles Lofts died in Tasmania 6th Jun 1853 after drowning in the South Esk River.

JOHN WOODLEY AND SARAH GOODWIN (G12-ASHDON)

John Woodley (#215) (1773-1833) christened 4th June 1773.was the son of William (#203) Woodley 1743 and Jane Norris. William his father was born in Ashdon, near Saffron Walden but seems to have moved to Saffron Walden before he married.

Sarah Goodwin (#216) (1772?-1861) was born between 1766 and 1772. She is inconsistent when declaring her age. She died 1861 Her first child was Ruth born 1788 when she was 16 and the last was Elizabeth born 1821 when she was 49. This is an unusual age range but not impossible

The most likely candidate is Sarah Goodwin, b 1st May 1762 and chr 22nd Feb 1767 in Essex to John and Hannah Goodwin. However, her children seem to have arrived very late in life! This is a concern.

MARRIAGE

There is a marriage of John Woodley to Sarah Goodwin on 28th Oct 1810 in Saffron Walden So, Sarah Goodwin was possibly John's second marriage, and possibly his first wife was also Sarah, though we cannot yet find the record. Or Sarah was married first to William Woodley and then to John Woodley. In fact that is a very interesting possibility Unfortunately there is a lack of clear marriage records.

They moved from rural Ashdon into a down-at-heel area of Saffron Walden. Their children were: John (#226) 1813, Sarah (221) 1815, Charlotte (#223) 1815, Elizabeth (#220) 1817/21 and Ann (#218) 1818

John and Sarah would have been quite old when they married. It is certainly feasible, but not proven, that John had previously married Elizabeth x in 1800 and/or Mary Stock in 1803 in Radwinter.

I suppose the best bet is that John (#215) married Elizabeth (#8409) and then Sarah Goodwin (#216) both in Ashdon, and that John (#3216) married Mary Stock (#8410) and then Sarah Buttle (#3217) both in Radwinter.

John Auger 1809 was the son of William Philip Auger (1775-1817) and Ann Burgess (1775-) His sister Sarah Auger b 1796 married John Wisken b 1796 and they had a son Charles Wiskin (#225) b 1819 who married Charlotte Woodley.

Charlotte Woodley and John Auger were married 6th October 1830. She could not have been older than 16, and possibly younger. He would have been 21. She would have been pregnant with John at the time. Their children included William b 14/5/1833 chr 10/11/1833 and Emma b 13/9/1840 chr 10/1/1841
John Auger was buried 30th July 1840 aged 31, so born 1809.

Charlotte Augar, daughter of John Woodley married Charles Wiskin, b 1818 son of John Wiskin, on 28th June 1846. They had a child James in 1847, chr 11th Apr 1847 and another child Charles 1852 who died in 1855.

"ESSEX STANDARD 19th Apr 1844

An extraordinary outcry was a few days since raised amongst the thickly populated and not very refined residents occupying Castle Street [Saffron Walden] against Mr James Archer a respectable butcher relative to his treatment of a boy in his service named Woodley by first beating and then hanging him. The case was soon afterwards investigated before the Borough Magistrates when it appeared that the boy was strongly addicted to thieving and in his master's absence last Thursday he was caught stealing a quantity of peas. On Mr Archer's return ..."

(The Woodley boy is likely to be John Auger, who reverted to being called Woodley see the 1841 census for Castle St, and who would have been 14 at the time and living in Castle Street)

This John of Ashdon, "son of William" (and from the census son of Susan) in this census married Elizabeth Webb, "dau of Lawrence Webb" in 1844 in Radwinter her home.

JOSEPH LOFTS WOODLEY AND ALICE BARRETT (G13 -ASHDON)

Joseph Lofts Woodley (#4126) was the illegitimate son, born 1839 of Sarah Woodley (#4125) who later married Charles Lofts (#4132)

It seems likely that, after his step-father Charles Lofts was transported, Joseph L Woodley joined the navy between 1841 and 1871 until returning to Ashdon where he married Alice Barrett Q2 1871 13th May 1871 in Saffron Walden. He was 32 and she was 20. However, the naval connection is not yet certain

They had seven children as listed in the 1891 census for Church End, Ashdon

Joseph Lofts Woodley died 1906 and buried 11th Sept 1906 in Ashdon

JOSEPH WOODLEY AND ELIZABETH CATON (G13-ASHDON)

Joseph Woodley (#3302) (1817 Ashdon-1890 Linton) bapt 30th Mar 1817 "to William and Susan",it is possible he was son of William Woodley (#3222) and Susan **Coote** (#3223)of Radwinter, but possibly there was another William and Susan in Ashdon.

There was also an Anne bapt 20th July 1820 in Ashdon and John 1814 who could be her sibling. This points towards the Coote option.

Elizabeth Caton (#3303) born 1818 or 1821 in Saffron Walden or Radwinter, though there is no obvious birth or baptism record, though there are for Gt Dunmow, Ingatestone and Braintree (Shalford).

They were married in Ashdon 5th July 1839.

"Joseph Woodley of full age labourer of Ashdon, father William married to Elizabeth Caton, a minor, daughter of John Caton. Witnesses John Woodley and Martha Barham"

The family moved in 1851 to Bartlow End, near Linton Cambs.

Harriet already had a son George Edward in 1861 John and Harriet had the following children

- William: 5th November 1869
- Louisa: 2nd May 1875 November 1882

After Harriet died in 1880 John married Mary Rule in 1886. John died 1926.

From 1891 to 1901 George Edward was living with his grandmother or perhaps step-grandmother, Betsy (Caton) Woodley.

Chelmsford Chronicle 11th September 1891

On Tuesday, Mr William Caten Woodley, of Homerton, youngest son of John Woodley, of Bartlow Hamlet, with whom he was staying on a visit, was getting into an empty harvest wagon, when the front ladder came out, causing him to fall, doubling his right leg under him and breaking the thigh. Pc. Lancum skilfully splintered the leg, after which Mr W. Woodley conveyed the sufferer to the Saffron Walden Hospital, where Dr Bartlett set the fracture.

This presumably refers to William Woodley born 1869.

William Caton Woodley (#3307) born 1850 or 1851, bapt 17th Jul 1867 in Ashdon, "son of Joseph and Eliz." married Mary Ann Smart (nee Taylor) in 1894. both second marriages. William died 1897 in Saffron Walden, his estate was granted probate of a will.

There are some newspaper advertisements (to be located) which suggest he owned some property including a freehold blacksmiths forge. John Woodley son of Josiah to Harriet Woodley dau of Thomas 6th May 1865 Castle Camps

Charles Woodley (#140) was born August 1819 bapt 5th Sept 1819 in Ashdon, was son of Thomas Woodley (#105) and Sarah Webb (#121) and therefore not closely related to our family.

"ESSEX STANDARD 19th Jan 1849

Charles Woodley, 31 labourer of Ashdon was indicted for obtaining money under false pretences from Mr William Chalk, carter. John Freestone servant of Mr Chalk deposed that on Sunday afternoon the 10th of December last the prisoner Woodley came to him and asked for the bill of the pork and the money for a ..."

Charles Woodley,.

Born August 1819 in Ashdon, a farm labourer, he married Sophia Chinery 9th Jan 1846 in Ashdon. He had 1 month in prison for poaching and 6 weeks for theft. He was found guilty of fraud at Saffron Walden assizes on 12th Jan 1849 and was sentenced to 7 years beyond the seas, Held in Portland Prison, Springfield and Millbank Gaols then to the prison hulk 'York' Transported on Pyrenees dep 14th March 1851 from Torbay, arrived Fremantle WA 28th June 1851. Died 31st July 1883 age 64 in Harvey WA. He married Emma Gardiner (b 1834 in Gloucestershire) in Bunbury WA and they had 10 children between 1856 and 1871. One of their children was Sarah who married Patrick Cahill (b 1836 Ireland) who as a soldier on 11th Sept 1862 in Colombo. tried to shoot a sergeant. He was sentenced to life and was transported back to Chatham and then to Western Australia. Nevertheless he and Sarah had 9 children.

In 1824 father Thomas (accompanied by Charles, only 5 years old) appeared at the December 1824 Special Assizes in Essex on a charge of larceny, but were found not guilty.

Charles married 9th Jan 1846 to Sophia Chinnery Leonard (#141) in Ashdon

In 1847 he was convicted of poaching (1 month imprisonment)

In 1847 6 weeks in prison for larceny

On 12th Jan 1849 he was convicted of fraud and sentenced to 7 years transportation

CHILDREN WITH SOPHIA Elijah 9th Apr 1848 Ashdon Walter Leonard Woodley 1845 Ellen Woodley 1851-1852

He stopped at Portland Prison, Springfield Gaol, Millbank prison, and the hulk 'York'

At this time he was married with 'one child' (actually he had two)., a labourer who could not read or write, and the family were living in Castle Camps.

Ellen seems to have been born while Charles was absent in prison

Transported on the Pyrennees dep 14th Mar 1851 from Torbay and arrived 28th Jun 1851 at Fremantle. Western Australia

There he married Emma Gardiner (#142) (b 1834 Glos) in 1861 in Bunbury WA

They had 10 children between 1856 and 1871

The children included Sarah born 1856 who married Patrick Cahill (born 1836) in 1875.

On 11th Sept 1862 Patrick, while a soldier in Colombo, had tried to shoot his colour sergeant and was sentenced to life in Western Australia. His route over a period of 2 years was Colombo to Millbank to Chatham to Western Australia

Together Patrick and Sarah had 9 children.

Charles Woodley died 31st July 1883 aged 64 in Harvey, Western Australia.

Charles Woodley was born in August 1819 in Ashdon, Essex, England. He died on 31 July 1883 in Harvey, Western Australia, Australia. When he was 41, he married Emma Gardiner, daughter of Reuben Gardiner and Ann Onslow Brown, on 30 April 1861 in Bunbury, Western Australia, Australia.

George Woodley was born in 1866 in Brunswick Junction, Western Australia, Australia. He died in 1875 in Australia, Western Australia, Australia.

Selina Woodley was born in 1868 in Ditchingham, Western Australia, Australia. Married Charles Rossmore Jarvis in 1896. She died in 1944. Lavinia Woodley was born on 25 August 1869. Married Joseph White She died in 1898.

Edith Ada Woodley was born on 3 May 1871 in Bunbury, Western Australia, Australia. She died on 25 October 1958 in Perth, Western Australia, Australia. She married Henry John Robinson in 1896 in Bunbury, Western Australia, Australia.

JOHN WOODLEY AND MARY AUGER (G14-SAFFRON WALDEN)

John Woodley

John Woodley (#2401) was born 1816 to 1818 in Saffron Walden (according to census records)

and was baptised 25th Nov 1821, son of William and Mary. It is quite difficult to reconcile who this Wiliam and Mary are as discussed in the notes in red.

BIRTH 1 FILE 12 John Woodley bapt 25th Nov 1821 in Essex son of William and Mary

Almost certainly, this John Woodley is John Woodley (#4122) son of William Woodley and Mary Ann Flack, bapt 1821.

It seems now increasingly likely, eliminating other options, that this John was the son of John Woodley and Sarah Goodwin

NOT John Woodley (#2401) (1821?-1895) was born in Saffron Walden, son of William (#)1794 and Amey (#) 1796 Woodley.of Littlebury. They are not closely related to us. There is a baptism record - "John bapt 11th Oct 1818 Littlebury, son of William and Amy". There are two JohnWoodleys in the 1851 census. One b 1819 is qith Willaim and Amy/Ann.(#2401) but this one is married to Mary Auger and is different.

NOT John Woodley (#415) was born 1816-1821 son of James Woodley and Ann Richardson, who married Charlotte Thurgood

Mary Ann Auger (#2402) was born 1816 dau of Henry Auger and Jane Warren

Henry Auger b 1782 and Jane Warren b 1786 were married 1807 in S/W. Jane Warren 1786 had a sister Elizabeth Warren b 1781, who describes herself as widow, but probably never married. Elizabeth Warren appears in the census records below.

- .4 Sarah Woodley, (#8446)born 1843 and bapt 14th Jan 1844. She married James King in Q4 1860 in Saffron Walden, soon after her sister Elisa's marriage. Witnesses Joseph Gates and Rebecca Sarah Webb.
- .5 Robert Woodley (#8233) b Q2 1851, bapt 13th July 1851 Saffron Woodley "to John Woodley labourer and Mary Anne". It appears that in 1871 he married Amelia Thurgood (#8234) and by the 1901 census for

Saffron Walden they had four children Arthur, Susan, Frederick and William.

.6 Jane Woodley (#8235) b 1852, bapt 13th Apr 1856 Saffron Walden "to John Woodley labourer and Mary". She married John Goodwin 12th Oct 1872 in Saffron Walden and they had 10 children.
